

# BROCKMAN genealogy

According to page 78 of the Brockman Scrapbook, by William Everett Brockman (published in 1952), Tanday Brockman (spelled "Tandy" in that publication) was the son of Samuel and Nancy Durrett Brockman, who were married on October 24, 1791 in Virginia. This Nancy Durrett was the daughter of Joel and Sarah Durrett.

The line of the above Samuel Brockman can be more easily traced in another book by William Everett Brockman, Orange County Virginia Families Volume III (OCVF3). On page 108 of that book, it shows Samuel Burrus Brockman married Nancy Durrett in 1791. Samuel Burrus Brockman was the son of John Brockman and Elizabeth Burrus. John Brockman was appointed a Lieutenant in February 1777. John Brockman married Elizabeth Burrus by 1776.

The parents of John Brockman were Samuel Brockman and wife Rebecker. Rebecker's last name is thought to be Ellis, daughter of John Ellis, according to page 28 of W. E. Brockman's book, Orange County Virginia Families Volume IV (OCVF4). Samuel Brockman married Rebecker by 1744. This Samuel died in 1790. Rebecker died in 1814.

This Samuel Brockman, father of John Brockman, is referred to as Samuel Brockman II, for his father was also Samuel Brockman. For clarity's sake, I will refer to the father of Samuel Brockman II as Samuel Brockman I. The parents of Samuel Brockman II were Samuel Brockman I and wife Mary. The will of Samuel Brockman I was probated in 1766. Wife Mary died in 1776.

There is much more that you can find in the above publications. Here is a recap of what I understand from the records I have, that adds to the information in your web page.

Henry Brockman immigrated to Maryland in 1674. He came from the Barbados. Conclusive documentation of who Henry's parents were has not been found.

Henry Brockman married Rebecca Samuell. Only one child is known to have been born, Samuel Brockman.

Samuel Brockman married Mary. They had many children, including Samuel Brockman II.

Samuel Brockman II married Rebecker (believed to be the daughter of John Ellis). They had many children, including John Brockman.

John Brockman married Elizabeth Burrus by 1776. They had many children, including Samuel Burrus Brockman. John and Elizabeth Brockman lived in Orange County, Virginia. Elizabeth died in 1835. Elizabeth was the daughter of Thomas Burrus and Frances Tandy. Frances Tandy was the daughter of Roger Tandy and Sarah Quarles. Roger Tandy was the son of Henry Tandy, Jr. and wife Priscilla. Priscilla was a widow of John Watson when she married Henry Tandy, Jr.. Henry Tandy, Jr. was the son of Henry Tandy and wife Rebecca.

Samuel Burrus Brockman married Nancy Durrett in 1791. They had many children, including Tandy Brockman. There is much to write at this point, but I will continue with Tandy Brockman's line instead.

Tandy Brockman married Martha Ship (or perhaps Shipp). They had many children, including William T. Brockman. The middle initial is thought to stand for Tandy, rather than Thomas, as you state.

William T. Brockman married Martha Lewis. They had many children, including **Clara E. Brockman**. I have not located any other information about Clara E. Brockman. There is much more information about her ancestors and siblings.

William T. and Martha Lewis also had Sara Caroline Brockman (b. 1853 d.1887). She married Joseph Rosco Bay.

Joseph R. Bay and Sarah Caroline had several children including Lillie G. Bay. She married David Anson Cisco.
